DON'T HAVE A JOB? NEED CHILD CARE TO FIND A JOB?



Before COVID, to get a child care voucher, low-income parents had to have a job or be in an education or training program.

Now, you can get a child care voucher for up to 6 months while you look for a job, pursue an education, or training.

WHAT IS A CHILD CARE VOUCHER?

With a child care voucher, you can access child care for young or school-aged children at participating providers.

HOW DO I APPLY?

1. Call 2-1-1 to start your application.
2. Look for a letter in the mail.
3. Call to make an appointment within 15 days of receiving the letter.
4. Get your documents ready for your appointment.

(Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, appointments are being held over the phone rather than in-person.)

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Your household income must be at or below 50% of the state median income:

3	\$52,641
4	\$62,668

**Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) does NOT count as income. Regular unemployment assistance DOES count as income.*

You do not need a SSN to apply, but your child must be a US citizen or have qualifying status.
