On June 9, the Local 26 Bargaining Committee met again with the Harvard Administration for negotiations.

The union presented new proposals covering holiday pay during layoffs, and that extra hours and overtime would be distributed fairly.

Harvard administration has presented a health care proposal that, if implemented, would shift costs onto us.

The Administration negotiating team was unable to answer our questions about their health care proposals.

Bargaining sessions are set for June 14, 15, and 17.

The Bargaining Committee has made it clear that we are ready to be leaders to secure truly healthy lives at Harvard.
