On June 3, the Local 26 Bargaining Committee met with the Harvard Administration. This was the first session where proposals were presented.

We proposed a number of things to make Harvard a more welcoming place to work. That included strengthening seniority in promotions, increased uniform allowances, and expanded civil rights and diversity protections for current and future workers.

We believe these proposals will move Harvard forward.

The University then presented a number of proposals including ones that would shift health care costs to employees.

We reiterated our commitment to maintaining affordable health care.
